At AIUB, it is essential to carry out regular tracers studies in order to determine relevant information about our alumni and plan out the work for the Office of Placement (OPA). In order to do this, OPA has the designated task of maintaining regular liaison with our graduates. Currently, the university has over 30,000 graduates, belonging to various programs spread across the 4 Faculties of AIUB.

The information contained in this report has been collected through completed questionnaires and reports which have been received from the graduates. The primary survey questionnaire for the purpose is a “Tracer Study” which we have found to be an effective and useful tool that enables us to gather accurate details of the university alumni over a certain period of time. Information gleaned from the above sources, helps us identify academic needs to ensure better career prospects for our alumni and also promotes improved academia through constructive corporate partnerships.

Over the years, the country has witnessed commendable improvement in its economic indicators and industrial output. The demands of the corporates, in terms of the areas of specialization they seek in their employees, are reflective of just that. 1. Objectives of this study

Aimed at collecting information about our alumni, this report is published on our University's website. This ensures that all concerned stakeholders of AIUB have access to the information contained therein. The aim here is to:

- Assess how AIUB's academic delivery has been facilitating the career prospects of its graduates
- Determine the relevance of our curriculum vis a vis requirements at their workplace
- Find out job priorities of our alumni and the employers
- Advise on ways of developing academia-corporate collaboration
- Suggest empirical basis for reforms of the curriculum and instructions, management processes, career development activities, improvement of facilities and services

2. Graduates and employment

AIUB has over the years developed different linkages with major corporate houses of the country. It is a common practice in different countries and ensures regular placements of the students and alumni. It also paves the way for greater cooperation between the two parties with regard to:

- Development of curriculum
- Promoting of research
- Participation of leading corporate personalities as university faculty, etc.

The University's Office of Placement and Alumni (OPA) was established in order to promote the dual linkages with both the country's corporate sector as well as its alumni. Needless to say, many of AIUB's graduates are now placed in eminent positions, thereby further strengthening these ties.

3. AIUB's Courses and Corporate Employment

In the face of a growing number of academic institutions in the country and the large number of students graduating each year, competition faced by fresh graduates is indeed stiff. It is thus vital that the curriculum that they have studied helps the graduates stand in good stead of getting suitable placements.

This study covers the graduates of the 20th Convocation, held in October 2021. Total number of graduates who took the 20th Convocation was 2,878, broken down by faculties as follows:

6. Major sectors of alumni employment

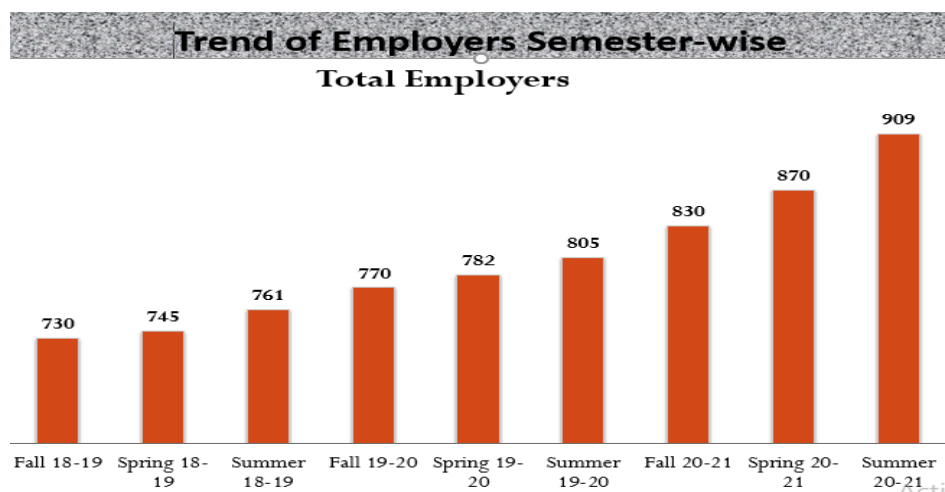
