

AIUB was represented by Dr. Carmen Z. Lamagna, Member, Board of Trustees and Former Vice Chancellor, and Prof. Dr. Dip Nandi, Associate Dean, Faculty of Science and Technology.

Prof. Nandi served as moderator for the Day 1 panel

“How Can Developing Countries Build AI That’s Truly Ours?” On Day 2, both delegates met AIFOD founders to discuss joint research, curriculum development, and knowledge exchange, and gave interviews on AI leadership and research. On Day 3, Dr. Lamagna participated in “Can AI Power Green Growth in Developing Economies?”, highlighting AIUB’s AI-driven campus energy management as a model for sustainable, locally grounded AI adoption aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

Professor Dr. Taslima Monsoor, Advisor, Department of Law, AIUB, and President of the Bangladesh Bioethics Society, participated in the 24th Asian Bioethics Conference held at the State University of Bangladesh (SUB) from 5–7 February 2026. The Conference brought together national and international scholars, policymakers, and experts to deliberate on the theme: “Bioethics in Building Nation-States.”

Professor Monsoor was invited as a distinguished speaker and played a significant role in the Conference

proceedings. She delivered the Opening Speech at the Inaugural Ceremony and addressed the audience at the Closing Ceremony.

During the academic sessions, Professor Monsoor presented a paper titled “Violence against Women: The Gendered Inequality and its Legal Connotations” (Presentation Preference: Oral). The paper examined violence against women as a deeply rooted social and legal issue in Bangladesh.
