Industrial Visit to the DESCO 132/33 KV Grid Substation

Thursday, January 09, 2025

On December 19th, 2024, and January 9th, 2025, the Faculty of Engineering (FE), AIUB Organized an Industrial Tour to the DESCO 132/33 KV Grid substation at Bashundhara R/A. 37 FE students, along with Prof. Dr. Muhibul Haque Bhuyan (EEE) visited the substation in 2 groups.

Engr. Saiful Islam, Assistant Engineer, DESCO of the grid substation, received the AIUB team upon their arrival. Later, the team was provided with a guided tour inside the substation area. They began at the supply side, where the substation is connected from Tongi and Rampura at 132

kV using two circuits through overhead cabling. Next, they showed the distribution side, where 5 distribution transformers are located to step down the voltage levels to 33 kV. In the control room, they demonstrated PLC and software-based operations, including connecting a transformer to the live grid. Engineers and technicians also showcased maintenance operations in the open field.

After the visit, Prof. Dr. Muhibul Haque Bhuyan thanked the substation officials and presented AIUB souvenirs in appreciation for their support.

MPH Students of AIUB Make Educational Field Trip of Industries

Saturday, January 11, 2025

On January 11, 2025, AIUB organized an interactive educational field visit for its Masters of Public Health (MPH) students to enhance their practical understanding of occupational health practices. Forty-five students visited three factories under Reedisha Industries Limited located in Gazipur — Reedisha Knitex, Reedisha Food & Beverage, and Formula One Spinning — where students engaged with industry experts, explored workplace health and safety challenges, and asked about occupational hazards and their prevention.

MPH students were surprised to find no mosquitoes in the visited

industries, likely due to cleanliness, covered drainage systems, and insecticide spraying. Mosquito fogging is done twice a week after work hours to avoid worker health risks.

The students expressed their gratitude to the management of Reedisha Ltd for giving them the opportunity to visit their industries and learn from them. “Most industries have restrictions for students visiting their industries, which becomes a challenge for our students to learn from”, remarked Dr. Wasif Alam, Head of the Dept. of Public Health at AIUB.

The Faculty of Engineering (FE), AIUB successfully organized the 4th International Conference on Robotics, Electrical, and Signal Processing Techniques 2025 (4th ICREST'25) from January 11-12, 2025.

At the inauguration, Chief Patron Dr. Carmen Z. 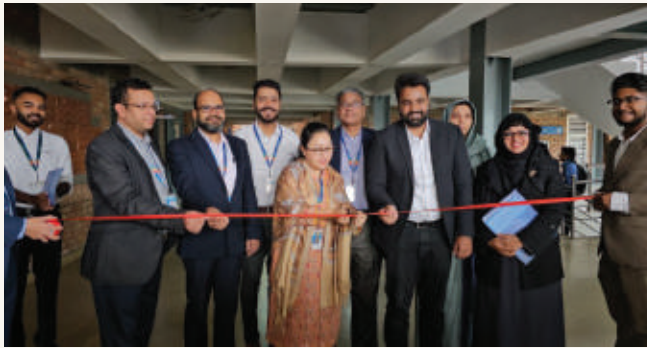
Q&A session.
