# Team AIUB\_Hydra Wins Champion Title at Research Spark: 3 Minute Thesis 2026



**Friday, April 3, 2026**

Team AIUB\_Hydra from the Department of Computer Science at AIUB secured the Champion title at ResearchSpark: 3 Minute Thesis 2026, organized by the IEOM society BUET Student Chapter on 3 April 2026. Competing against more than 270 participants from over 20 universities, the team advanced to the final round as one of 13 teams selected from 95 submissions.

The team presented PlasmaXAI, a counterfactual explanation-driven framework designed for malignant

plasma cell detection in multiple myeloma diagnosis, with a strong emphasis on interpretability and clinical relevance.

The team was led by Arnob Aich Anurag, with Shamiul Islam and Sadia Sultana as team members, and they were awarded the Champion distinction.

**Sunday, April 12, 2026**

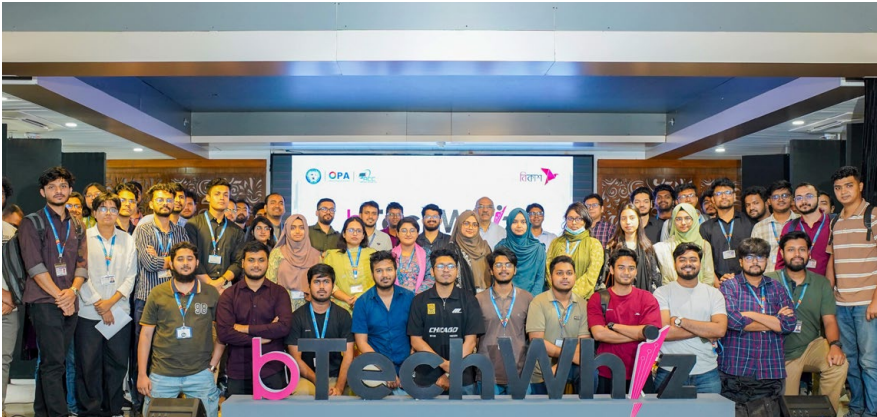

The tournament featured 24 departmental teams and

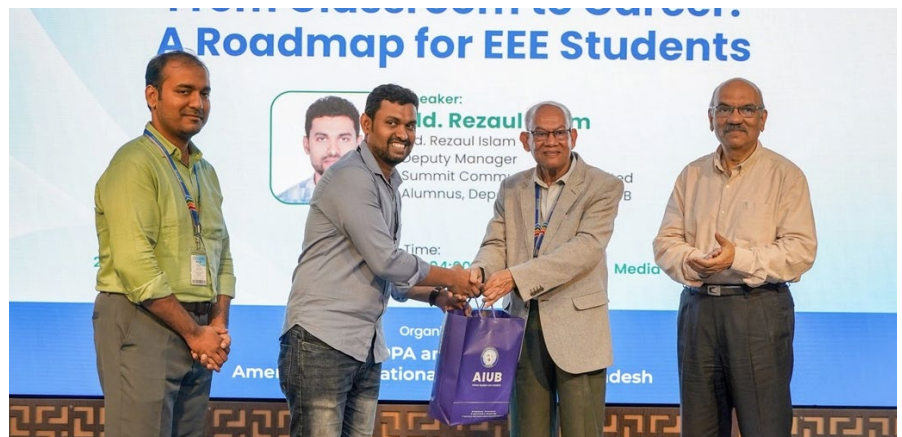
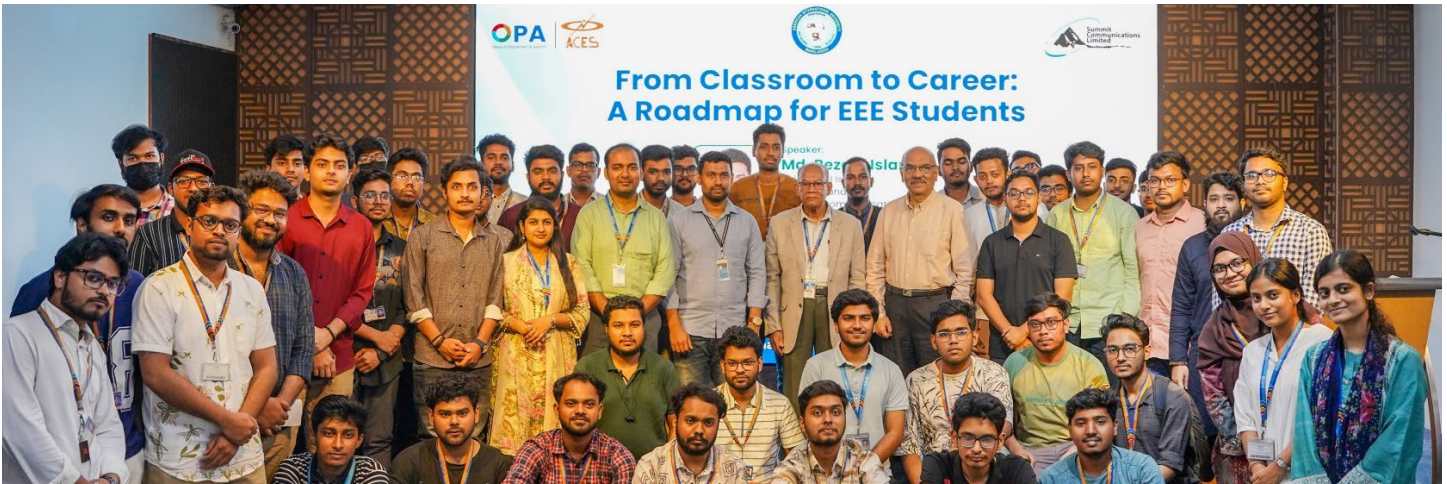

The first phase focused on spatial analysis using DepthmapX, covering space syntax, axial and VGA analysis, and spatial hierarchy. The second phase concentrated

on environmental analysis using Rhinoceros 3D, Grasshopper, and Ladybug Tools, with simulations on sun path, shadow analysis, and solar radiation using a real-world site in Cumilla.

The workshop was proposed and coordinated by Farzana Siddiqua, Assistant Professor and Research Moderator, Urbanism and Human Settlement Domain, and Md. Sariful Islam, Assistant Professor, Studio Guide, Urban Design, under the guidance of Mr. Arefeen Ibrahim, Head, Department of Architecture.

# Trusted AI in Higher Education and Research - THE Asia Universities Summit 2026

Dr. Carmen Z. Lamagna and Ms. Dulce Corazon Z. Lamagna, Members of the Board of Trustees, AIUB, attended Day 2 of the THE Asia Universities Summit 2026 at HKUST, joining the session “Trusted AI in Higher Education and Research: Governance, Capability and Institutional Strategy,” moderated by Anders Karlsson.

Panelists Yike Guo (HKUST), Flora Ng (University of Hong Kong), and Parichart Sthapitanonda (Chulalongkorn University) discussed how generative

AI is reshaping teaching, research, and university operations. Key recommendations included embracing AI with open ethical discussion, mandatory AI literacy training, formal governance policies, and equitable access to AI platforms.

A central takeaway was the “3 Ps” framework — platform, performance, and policy — to guide AI adoption across all stakeholders, ensuring academic integrity while improving student success, research outcomes, and institutional resilience.

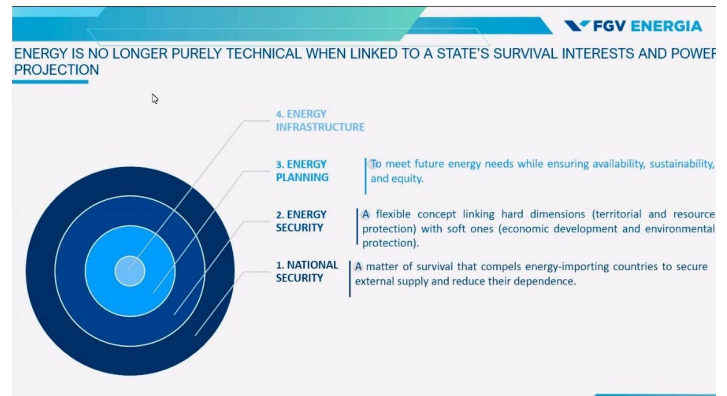
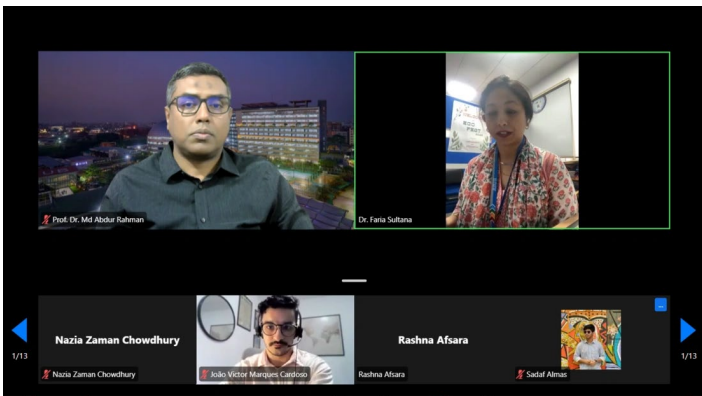
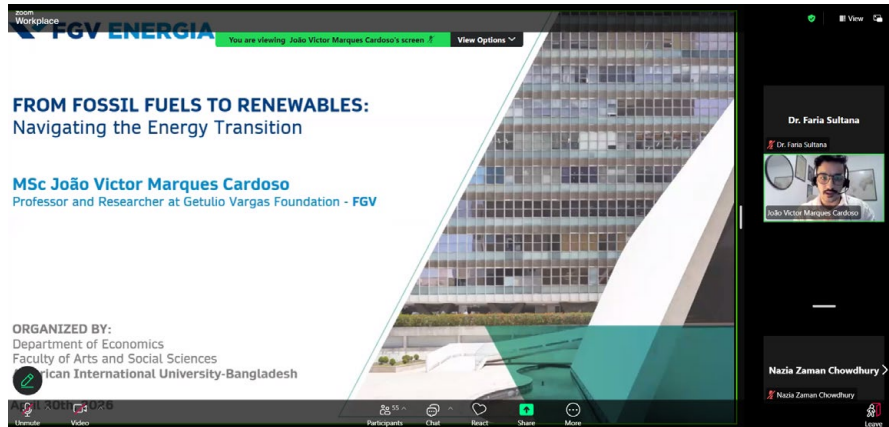

**Thursday, April 30, 2026**

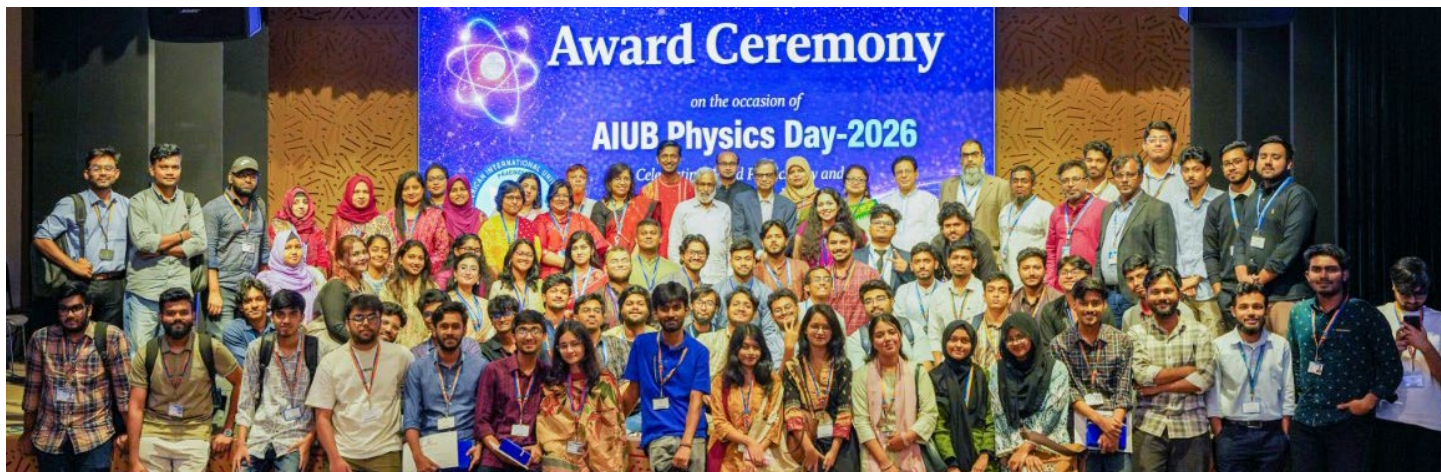
