AIUB Law Students Participate in the UNODC's Workshop on Trafficking in Persons and Smuggling of Migrants



Saturday, May 2, 2026

Ms. Ferdousi Begum, Assistant Professor, Department of Law, AIUB, led two students, Ms. Sajida Selim and Mr. Yousuf Haque Sami, to participate in the “Workshop on Trafficking in Persons and Smuggling of Migrants: Building a Youth Network,” held on May 2, 2026, at Eastern University, Savar, Dhaka.

Organized by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) in collaboration with Eastern University and funded by the European Union, the

workshop aimed to raise awareness about human trafficking and migrant smuggling among university students and build a strong youth network to combat these crimes.

Technical sessions covered UNODC’s Education for Justice modules, legal frameworks, human rights, investigation trends, and national challenges. The program also featured group discussions, a quiz competition, and a certificate distribution ceremony.

AIUB Inaugurates AI Supercomputing Lab

AIUB inaugurated its state-of-the-art AI Supercomputing Lab on May 3, 2026. The lab was inaugurated by Ms. Nadia Anwar, Chairman, Board of Trustees; Dr. Hasanul A. Hasan, Founder Member, Board of Trustees; Mr. Ishtiaque Abedin, Founder Member, Board of Trustees; and Dr. Carmen Z. Lamagna, Former Vice Chancellor and Member, Board of Trustees, in the presence of Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Saiful Islam and Pro Vice-Chancellor Prof. Dr. Md. Abdur Rahman.

The lab features advanced NVIDIA DGX Spark systems delivering up to 1 petaflop of AI performance, enabling work with large-scale AI models including large language models and diffusion systems. A key focus is developing “Sovereign AI” tailored to the Bengali language, with applications spanning healthcare, agriculture, smart cities, and the textile industry, strengthening Bangladesh’s AI research ecosystem and empowering future innovators.

A faculty-supervised student research team from AIUB won the Best Poster Presentation Award (Track: Nuclear Energy) at the International Conference on Electronics and Informatics 2026 (ICEI 2026), organized by Bangladesh Electronics and Informatics Society and hosted by the Atomic Energy Centre, Dhaka, on May 7–8, 2026.

The awarded research, titled “Evaluation of Social Viewpoint and Feasibility of Small Modular Nuclear Reactors (SMRs) for Baseload Power Generation Across the Coastal Regions of Bangladesh,” was supervised

by Md. Mortuza Ahmmed, Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, AIUB. The research team comprised Sumaita Tasnim, Ahmed Aahan Addin, Sadiha Rahman, Shahriar Sadib, and Arizit Chaki Artha.

Notably, Md. Mortuza Ahmmed also supervised 37 additional research paper submissions at ICEI 2026, reflecting AIUB’s strong institutional participation and commitment to fostering student research at national and international academic platforms.

These achievements, formally recognized through WURI certificates, reflect AIUB's continuous efforts to foster a culture of innovation, strengthen industry-academia collaboration, and prepare students for real-world challenges, placing it among leading institutions driving transformative approaches in global education and research.
