

AIUB inaugurated a new professional course titled "RTL Design, Verification, Synthesis and PnR for Digital VLSI Design" on October 5, 2025. Offered through a collaboration between the AIUB Institute of Continuing Education (AIUB ICE) and the Dr. Anwarul Abedin Institute of Innovation (D2A2I), the course aims to bridge academic learning with industry needs, preparing participants with specialized skills in advanced digital VLSI design.

The event began with an address by Dr. Shahriyar Masud Rizvi, Deputy

Director, CVES, and Associate Professor, EEE. Mr. Ataus Shafi, co-instructor and Physical Design Engineer, shared insights on the curriculum. Prof. Dr. A.B.M. AIUB Participates at the Bangladesh Oxygen Summit 2025 Organized by icddr,b

Tuesday, October 7, 2025

On October 7, 2025, icddr,b hosted the Bangladesh Oxygen Summit 2025 at InterContinental Dhaka under the theme "National Roadmap to Safe, Affordable and Reliable Medical Oxygen for All." The event united policymakers, scientists, development partners, and private sector representatives to advance universal oxygen access. Established in 2022 by icddr,b Scientist Dr. Ahmed Ehsanur Rahman, the Bangladesh Commission on Medical Oxygen Security includes 18 academic experts and 40 advisors working to ensure no one dies from oxygen shortage.

The innovation session featured technologies such as Bubble CPAP (icddr,b), OxyJet (BUET), Nishshash Ventilator (DIU), and a low-cost oxygen flow controller (AIUB). Dr. Mohammad Hasan Imam, Associate Professor, FE, AIUB, delivered a technical talk, and Md. Sayzar Rahman Akash, Research Assistant, CBR, D2A2I, presented a poster based on their IEEE Access publication. The summit concluded with a declaration recognizing medical oxygen as a human right.

Empowering Women in Science: Catalyzing Global Innovation and Progress at THE World Academic Summit 2025


Wednesday, October 8, 2025

AIUB proudly announces the outstanding international achievement of students from the Department of Computer Science, who represented Bangladesh at the World Youth Invention and Innovation Award (WYIIA) 2025, organized by the Indonesian Young Scientist Association (IYSA) in Surabaya, Indonesia, from October 14–17, 2025. The event hosted 355 teams from 16 countries, including Bangladesh, Hong Kong, Canada, South Korea, and Malaysia.

The AIUB team earned two major distinctions — Gold Medal in the

Technology Category and the IYSA Semi Grand Award. Team members included Rayan Alam (Leader), Hasibul Hasan, and Md. Mehedi Hasan Ratul. Their project used drone-based imaging and machine learning to estimate rice yields early, helping farmers make data-driven decisions. Bangladesh has taken a defining step toward its semiconductor future with the launch of the Center of Research Excellence in Semiconductor Technology (CREST), conceived and led by Non-Resident Bangladeshis (NRBs) to strengthen the nation's technological sovereignty.

Established under BASICS and aligned with the BEAR Summit vision, CREST aims to position Bangladesh as a Silicon River of innovation and global collaboration. Supported by Neural Semiconductor Ltd. and two global leaders, its first year includes 9 graduate fellowships from 7 universities — BUET, University of Dhaka, North South University, BRAC University, United International University, University of Asia Pacific, and East West University — guided by 9 faculty mentors and linked with UC Berkeley, Purdue University, and others.

The initiative also features 6 national training centers at AIUB, BUET, DU, IUT, MIST, and UIU to train 120 professionals. As part of this nationwide effort,



AIUB will host one of the CREST national training centers, supported by its active semiconductor research environment and strong industry collaborations.


