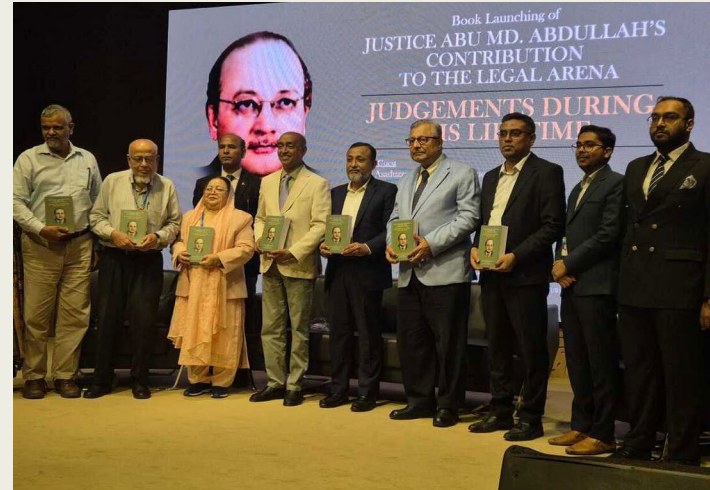
Book Launching - Justice Abu Md Abdullah's Contribution to the Legal Arena: Judgements During His Lifetime

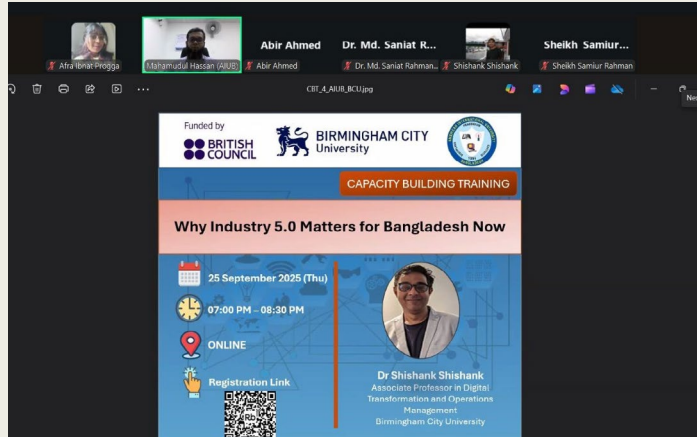
