Events Rules, Regulations, and Contact Points

• Venue: D building Multipurpose Hall, D building 9th floor, Classrooms, AIUB

• Date: 18th December 2025 - 21ST December 2025

Students of Schools, Colleges, Universities and AIUBians.

TEAM FORM REGULATIONS:

- ➤ For Team Games (Rocket League, Valorant, PUBG Mobile, MLBB), there are five ways to form a team
 - 1. Only School and College Students
 - 2. School, College + AIUB Students
 - 3. School, College + Other University Students
 - 4. AIUB + Other University Students
 - 5. Only AIUB Students

For Team Games, teams made up of only other university students are not acceptable.

Notice:

- 1. ACC will set up a booth on campus premises for on-campus registration for AIUB students. AIUBians have to register themselves within 24 hours from booth.
- 2. Only current Students from AIUB/ Other University/ School/ College are allowed to play. During the game must bring your institute's valid ID.
- **3.** BKash / Nagad No. is for registration.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Guardians and participants must bring a **Student ID or National ID, or any valid Photo ID card** for entry. Without a valid photo ID, entry will be restricted.
- 2. Registration must be completed between 8:00 AM and 9:30 AM on the event's opening day (18-12-2025). Upon completing registration, participants will receive an event kit containing an ID card and other materials. Only the participants playing on the LAN (On Campus) will get Kits.
- 3. After sending the registration fee via **bKash/Nagad**, participants are requested to **call from their bKash number (or any other number)** and mention the **transaction ID** to ensure a smooth registration process.
- 4. All participants must attend the Opening Ceremony to collect their event kit. No kits will be distributed after the ceremony.
- 5. The number of participants is limited. A **first-come**, **first-served** policy will be followed.
- 6. Food and drinks are not allowed inside the playing area (LAN).
- 7. All gaming accessories will be provided except joysticks (for Rocket League, FC25) and headphones. Participants may bring their own accessories (keyboard, mouse, headphones, etc.) except Monitors.

- 8. Registration fees are non-refundable.
- 9. The event schedule will be maintained **strictly**. If anyone misses their scheduled time, they **will not be allowed** to participate.
- 10. **Alcohol and smoking materials** are strictly prohibited at the venue.
- 11. **Garbage and waste** must be disposed of properly in the bins and recycling points provided.
- 12. **Anti-social behavior** (including, but not limited to, **Sexual harassment**, urination or defectation outside designated restrooms or any **inappropriate behavior**) will **not be tolerated.** Offenders will be **immediately removed and banned** from the event without refund.
- 13. Any type of disrespectful activity on social platforms against ACC or organizing committee may lead to serious consequences (eg. Ban, Penalty, Disqualification)
- 14. The **organizing committee reserves the right** to change any rules at any time. Their decision will be **final.**

Allegation and Evidence Policy

- 1. Any form of **allegation** (e.g., cheating, misconduct, or unfair advantage) must be supported by **valid recorded proof**, such as video clips, screenshots, or official logs.
- 2. **Verbal or unverified complaints** will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 3. Participants must **submit their evidence** to the respective **game lead or event coordinators** within the specified time frame after the incident.
- 4. **Allegations without proof**, or those **submitted after the review period**, will be considered **invalid**.
- 5. This policy **applies uniformly to all games** in the tournament.

Some Rules and Regulations for PARTICIPATION:

- 1) If any game is finished earlier than the announced time, then the fixtures will be published earlier as well.
- 2) The opening ceremony will start at 9:00 am. Every contestant must be present at the opening ceremony.
- 3) Every contestant must attend the opening ceremony to get his/her t-shirt and must bring their ID card and valid information to get himself/herself verified. Participants must collect a participation ID Card and a guardian ID Card, which will be given only on that day.
- 4) There won't be any registration booth for on-spot registration in the venue of the gaming.
- 5) Schools, colleges, and universities can combine their team. At least 1 person from the school/college must be present on the team. Other universities in a team are not allowed.
- 6) Fees are to be paid to the given BKash / Nagad account number.
